We offer Children's Church during the worship service and Children's Sunday School right after the worship service.






As we study the Gospel of John together, we hope you will engage in our new ministry of placing a copy of John into the hands of those to whom God's Holy Spirit leads.



John 5

Series Theme Verses: Therefore many other signs Jesus also performed in the presence of the disciples, which are not written in this book; but these have been written so that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that believing you may have life in His name. John 20:30-31



Daniel 7:13-14

I kept looking in the night visions, and behold, with the clouds of heaven One like a <u>Son of Man</u> was coming, and He came up to the <u>Ancient of Days</u> and was presented before Him. <u>And to Him was given dominion</u>, glory and a <u>kingdom</u>, that all the peoples, nations and men of <u>every language might serve Him</u>. His dominion is an <u>everlasting dominion which will not pass away</u>; and His kingdom is one which will not be destroyed.

John 11:39

Jesus said, "Remove the stone." Martha, the sister of the deceased, said to Him, "Lord, by this time there will be a stench, for he has been dead four days."

Luke 16:22

Now the poor man died and was carried away by the angels to Abraham's bosom; and the rich man also died and was buried.

Luke 7:12-15

Now as He approached the gate of the city, a dead man was being carried out, the only son of... a widow... When the Lord saw her, He felt compassion for her, and said to her, "Do not weep." And He came up and touched the coffin; and the bearers came to a halt. And He said, "Young man, I say to you, arise!" The dead man sat up and began to speak.



Philippians 2:9-11

For this reason also, God highly exalted Him, and bestowed on Him the name which is above every name, so that at the name of Jesus EVERY KNEE WILL BOW, of those who are in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and that every tongue will confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

Romans 8:1

Therefore there is now <u>no</u> condemnation for those who are <u>in</u> Christ Jesus.

Luke 24:36-37

While they were telling these things, He Himself stood in their midst and said to them, "Peace be to you." <u>But they were startled and frightened and thought that they were seeing a spirit.</u>
