I. The Revelation of the Lord 15a

2 Timothy 1:10 But now has been revealed by the appearing of our Savior Christ Jesus, who abolished death and brought life and immortality to light through the gospel.

John 5:24-25 Truly, truly, I say to you, he who hears My word, and believes Him who sent Me, has eternal life, and does not come into judgment, but has passed out of death into life. Truly, truly, I say to you, an hour is coming and now is, when the dead will hear the voice of the Son of God, and those who hear will live.

II. The Return of the Lord 14-15

2 Corinthians 5:6 & 8 Therefore, being always of good courage, and knowing that while we are at home in the body we are absent from the Lord- we are of good courage, I say, and prefer rather to be absent from the body and to be at home with the Lord.

Ecclesiastes 12:7 Then the dust will return to the earth as it was, and the spirit will return to God who gave it.



James 2:26 For just as the body without the spirit is dead, so also faith without works is dead.

Acts 17:30-34 Therefore having overlooked the times of ignorance, God is now declaring to men that all people everywhere should repent, because He has fixed a day in which He will judge the world in righteousness through a Man whom He has appointed, having furnished proof to all men by raising Him from the dead. Now when they heard of the resurrection of the dead, some began to sneer, but others said, "We shall hear you again concerning this." But some men joined him and believed...

John 11:43 When He had said these things, He cried out with a loud voice, "Lazarus, come forth."

John 5:28-29 Do not marvel at this; for an hour is coming, in which all who are in the tombs will hear His voice, and will come forth...

Acts 8:39 When they came up out of the water, the Spirit of the Lord <u>snatched</u> Philip away; and the eunuch no longer saw him, but went on his way rejoicing.

2 Corinthians 12:2 I know a man in Christ who fourteen years ago—whether in the body I do not know, or out of the body I do not know, God knows—such a man was <u>caught up</u> to the third heaven.

Acts 23:10 And as a great dissension was developing, the commander was afraid Paul would be torn to pieces by them and ordered the troops to go down and <u>take him away from them by force</u>, and bring him into the barracks.
